#### III. Update on CCP plan implementation

*Brief review current status of CCRC staffing and Community Corrections Partnership plan program service elements and other executive-body approved actions.*

Bill reported that Kevin Samsel is now the Supervising Probation Officer at CCRC. Kevin said he met with jail staff this morning and discussed some issues. Bill reported that another Horses Help group started this week. Observations from the 1<sup>st</sup> group were discussed. Bill said that a high percentage of people are going to prison. How do we reach the higher risk population?

#### IV. Public Comment (as time permits)

*Open discussion of the ongoing or emerging impacts on the community of Public Safety Realignment.*

Wes Harrison talked about conduct and attitudes at Crossroads. Incentives aren't working like they used to. The programs that would be possible when the new jail is built were discussed. PRCS data and Prop 47 was discussed. Crossroads is at 80% capacity; they are getting people coming in. The support from Probation and Mental Health is good.

Amy Cone said they are working on making data available to CCRP.

Medi-cal billing was discussed. Wes says they are still working on it. Probation will be going back to TCM.
