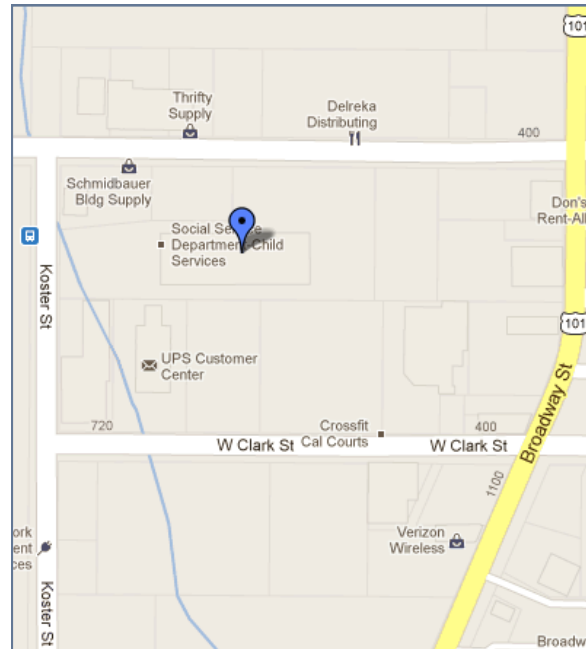

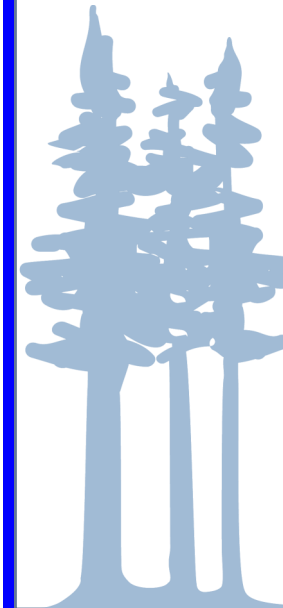

HumWORKs Behavioral Health Services



Overview

HumWORKs (Humboldt Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) provides behavioral health services to CalWORKs Welfare-to-Work participants.

The program focus is on supporting recovery for those facing mental health, substance abuse and/or domestic violence issues.

HumWORKs offers a safe, supportive environment to address barriers to work and to become self-sufficient.

What is CalWORKs?

The CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) program is intended to provide temporary cash assistance to families while they are working to become self-sufficient. There are two components to the CalWORKs program:

- 1) Cash Aid is available for families who apply and qualify for assistance with housing, food, and other necessary expenses.
- 2) Welfare-to-Work helps family members acquire skills to get a job and prepare for employment.

CalWORKs is there for families who are temporarily in need of assistance to become self-sufficient. Adults in families that are eligible may receive benefits for up to 48 months.
