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### Minutes

#### I. Call to order

Shaun Brenneman called the meeting to order at 12:15pm. In attendance was: Coral Sanders, Wes Harrison, Darren Ghisetti, Lynn Kerman, and Michelle Tucker.

#### II. Report out on CCP Executive Committee meeting 01/16/2019

*Review agenda items covered, discussions held and actions taken.*

Shaun reported out on the Executive Committee meeting:

- Funding was approved for a 1-year pilot program between the Probation Department and Arcata House. Arcata House will be providing a 5 bed facility to PRCS offenders who are in need of transitional housing once released from prison. This facility will be working with Probation Officers and DHHS Case Managers to help PRCS offenders find permanent housing and sign up for additional assistance services.
- DHHS received funding to send 17 employees from various county departments to the annual Crisis Intervention Training held in Seattle Washington.

#### III. Update on CCP plan implementation

*Brief review current status of CCRC staffing and Community Corrections Partnership plan program service elements and other executive-body approved actions.*

Shaun provided current updates on the Executive Committee Departments:

- Probation: There are 2 current AB109 vacancies. One will be filled shortly and the other will remain vacant as SRP caseloads are manageable.
- Jail: The jail expansion project is entering the “project establishment phase.”
- DHHS: Currently has both RN and Clinician vacancies.
- Courts: Working on the launch of their new case management system eCourt.

Wes/Crossroads: There has been an increase in Probation referrals to the program. Currently, the availability for county beds is limited until the new fiscal year begins. Drug Medi-Cal was pushed out an additional 6 months.

Lynn/RCAA: Case Management update – there are currently 3 case managers at each site. The 4<sup>th</sup> case manager will be splitting their time between Waterfront Recovery Center and Humboldt Recovery Center. The data portion of this project has been worked out with Probation.

A discussion took place in regards to the RCAA case managers participating in training opportunities that would apply to their respective jobs at the treatment programs.

Shaun agreed that Probation will inform RCAA of any trainings that are held that would be appropriate for the case managers to attend.
