AJ's Living- Client in need</p>	<p>AJ's Living has had a good relationship working with County MH in the past. But, the other day a counselor called to discuss why a few clients were let go. AJ's Living felt like it could have been handled better, and that County MH counselors should have a better understanding of the responsibility AJ's Living has for the safety of all their residents. Sue suggested that everyone should meet and potentially visit the house. Jeanine would like to know about a potential Exit Strategy for MH/ County Clients who are let go.</p> <p>This has been discussed at earlier meetings. IDDT is being used by more counselors.</p> <p>Marguerite discussed substance use disorder funding. In Sacramento, they would use CalWORKS first, then DMC because CalWORKS is time-sensitive. Also, SAPT BG is based on the number of clients who use it. So, funding may be increased by treating more clients. Sue discussed the way Humboldt County's funds are setup.
