### NEW BUSINESS

#### IV: **Crisis Intervention Training (CIT) Conference Funding Request - Action Item \$29,970**

*DHHS, in partnership with Local LE agencies, propose to fund 10 staff to the International CIT conference held in Pittsburg CA between August 29, and August 31, 2022.*

Kelly Johnson reviewed the request and a discussion about the attendees occurred. Public Defender's office is being add to a waitlist if any of the purposed attendees are unable to make the training.

Chief Sligh made a motion to approve the request. Judge Elvine-Kreis seconded. Motion Carried.

## **V. Agency Report Outs – Discussion Item**

Director Beck reported that Behavioral Health received a grant to expand the MIST program with work with the sheriff's office. This should be very helpful and will hopefully have a positive impact on the local emergency departments. The only concern is the staffing to fill those positions. Director Beck reported that all of DHHS is struggling to staff positions.

Division Director Sanders reported that the Community Corrections Resource Center is staffed and the wave of COVID absences seems to have decreased. She reported that due to short staff in the Juvenile Hall, Probation Officers will be covering shifts. Probation is struggling to fill the juvenile corrections positions.

### **VI. Sequential Intercept Mapping Resumption – Discussion Item**

*Postponed due to Governor's proposed CARE Court. County will resume SIM once details of CARE court plan are better understood.*

Although SIMS was planned on returning, it is on pause while waiting for more information about CARE court. There is concerns that Humboldt County lacks the infrastructure to support what is known as it is currently proposed as an unfunded mandate. Judge Elvine-Kreise reported he will share information as the courts receive. It.

### **VII. Update on CCP Trust and Budget -Discussion Item**

*Probation will report out on the current state of the AB109 trust.*

Legal Office Business Manager – Elisha Hardison reported that a true balance of the trust is pending 20-21 journal entries to post. She is also waiting for request for Q2 funding. In addition revenues are up and COVID restrictions create a savings in training specific funding which is around the \$400,000 range.
