Judge Hinrichs reported on the transition from COVID to open court and they are determining where to have court and how to house youth while waiting for court. The Court system is trying to balance the benefits of remote appearances with maintaining rights.

HC-TAYC reported that they have their first in person Peer led workshop since COVID. They have expanded their MWF hours to include mornings. Peer Coaching pilot project in Juvenile Hall is going well.

CWS- Struggling with recruitment and retention, building protocols with all local tribes.

HCOE- Now have a career guidance technician working in JH with Junior/Seniors and Graduates. Youth are reporting that they like the program and are planning for the future. Some graduates are doing CR courses and one youth is doing concurrent CR enrollment.

Project Rebound reported They are hosting a Boundless Freedom Project. New position starting soon; Youth Coordinating Specialist starting May 1st.

DA- New Juvenile DA had been working domestic violence cases since 2015 will be collaborating with probation to review probation's role.

Providence Paso a Paso offer a variety of services and over 200 classes and support groups, including groups in Spanish. They can also connect youth to cultural services
