### V. PROGRAM (10-15minutes): Special Education in the County School System.

Roger Golec from HCOE was in attendance to report out on Special Education in the Humboldt County School System.

- Data was presented on the homeless youth count in the school system.
- There has been an increase in the homeless rate of students. This could be due to better reporting mechanisms, historic unemployment, and a housing shortage of low-income housing. Economic reasons also play a large role.
- Handouts were provided to demonstrate the current numbers associated with Special Education in Humboldt County.

- There are currently 3,859 students receiving Special Education services; 1,493 McKinney-Vento youth; and 187 McKinney-Vento Special Education youth in the county school system.

**VI. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:**

**A. BSCC Title II Juvenile Grant**

Shaun Brenneman reported that the grant application for this has been pulled back and has not been reposted yet. Chief Brenneman will keep everyone updated as he receives information from the state.

**VII. AGENCY REPORTS/ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION OPEN TOPIC**

Felicia Doherty/Community Schools: the schools are getting ready for graduations to take place; L-CAPS have been presented.

Sacha Marini/Teen Court: An MOU has been put in place with the local mall regarding youth who shoplift. Teens who have been caught shoplifting are being given the option to join Teen Court rather than being banned from the mall. To date, there has not been much interest from the youth to participate in Teen Court.

Jeremy Nilsen/Mental Health: New office space is still currently under construction at Humboldt Plaza. It is estimated they are six months out from completion. This will allow for Mental Health to be co-located with Child Welfare Services.

Roger Golec/HCOE: There is a new homelessness case worker that has started at HCOE.

Patrick O'Neill/EPD: EPD currently has 8 officer vacancies. The department will be hosting a -day CSI camp for youth this summer

Jody Green/Probation: There is a new Juvenile Intake Supervising Probation Officer, Petrina Fennell. Jody will be retiring as the Juvenile Division Director on May 31<sup>st</sup>. A replacement will be chosen shortly after.

Shaun Brenneman/Probation: A data sheet was provided regarding the juvenile probation youth over the past 90 days.
