- Shaun Brenneman/Probation: The new estimated timeline for drug medical is October 2019; CCRC has a new Supervising Probation Officer; CCRC will be re-evaluating their Mental Health resources to provide an accurate assessment of the staffing and services they will need.
- Lynn Kerman/RCAA: All case manager positions are filled; The program appears to be progressing. Case managers have been attending local trainings.
- Wes Harrison/ NCSAC: Current staff at Crossroads are furloughed. This is hoped to end in the new fiscal year. There has been an increase in population due to serving different clients such as probation, parole, etc..
- Shar-Lo Kelly/Public Defender: The PD's office is currently looking to employ a social worker to work with their clients.
