NEW BUSINESS

IV: Crisis Intervention Training (CIT) conference funding request- Action Item \$34,970

CCP Executive Committee previously approved \$29,970 for cohort to attend CIT conference on March 16, 2022. This proposal would increase funding by \$5000 to cover increased flight costs.

V. Assisted Out-patient Treatment (AOT) presentation by DHHS- Discussion Item

DHHS to present regarding roll out of AOT in Humboldt County

Deputy Director Jack Breazeal presented on AOT, starting a training program for educating the community and law enforcement agencies on the referral process and the process for court ordered treatment. There was some discussion on

whether the jail could start the referral process. Director Beck to provide more information about the AOT process.

VI. Well Path- Discussion Item

Discussion regarding increase of Well Path costs

Discussion about the updated cost past the 4.2 nursing staff that was previously presented and approved. Probation and Sheriff's office to set up a meeting with CAO for a discussion and new action item for next CCP Meeting.

VII. Agency Report Outs – Discussion Item

Courts – working with behavioral health regarding AOT, tentatively going to Judge Canning. After ride along with EPD officer Ross, Judge Elvine-Kreis would like Probation to look into community service opportunities to assist Officer Ross with clean up so he can focus on outreach.

Ferndale Police department – Nothing to report

DHHS – Community Correction Resource center only missing part time clinician, Jail missing two clinicians and SUD Counselor. Director Beck reported with the hiring freeze it may be harder to get those positions filled. DHHS is working on a 10 bed crisis intervention residence, struggling with finding the right property and will start community meeting August 23. Director Beck to have a presentation on the Navigation Center DHHS is working on opening.

District Attorney's Office – reported COVID continues to cause staffing issues

Sheriff's Office – Will be coming back with a proposal for training funds to send Crisis Negotiation Team to National conference

Probation – no major changes, staffing and hiring is a continued priority. New probation officers to start at the Community Corrections Center but are also covering Juvenile Hall.
