

**McKinleyville Municipal Advisory Committee's

Minutes / Meeting Notes**

August 4, 2025, 4:00 - 5:00 pm at the McKinleyville Family Resource Center's Small Conference Room

1. Attendees: Bonnie Oliver, Angeline Holtski (on Zoom), Lisa Dugan, Megan Blumenstein, Oona Smith (HCAOG, on Zoom).
2. Agenda approved.
3. Minutes of the July 9, 2025 meeting were approved with one spelling correction.
4. **Discussion of the proposed Quick Build Project for Hiller Road from Central to McKinleyville Avenue:**
 - a. Review of "Letter of Interest to Muralists", "Call for Proposals: Mural Art Quick Build" and "Business Sponsorship Request – Mural Project" prepared by Megan Blumenstein and Katie Mather of Sea Goat Farm Stand and Folk School:

Keoki Burbank told Megan person they had in mind, Casey Peterson, is not available but gave Megan a recommendation on another muralist, Sorren Richards from Hoopa. Alme Allen will be contacted by Megan. Megan shared a Flyer for social media with QR codes, one for sponsorship and one for muralists to apply. Committee members supported the flyer design. Megan and Katie will go to businesses and personally invite them to an opportunity to sponsor a mural section. And speak to people on Hiller Road about the project. At the July Chamber Mixer at SeaGoat an announcement about business sponsorships for the Hiller Quick Build Street Art Project was made. No one came forward to sponsor, but awareness was built on the quick build project. We'll need to turn it around quickly, early September. Megan to connect this week with MUSD contacts. Bonnie may provide contacts to NHUHS via Jim Ritter. Oona Smith brought up that it would be good to let artists know they will be paired up with volunteers (some maybe youth). Megan will clarify. It was also suggested that we name CRTP and Ace Hardware (possible paint provider) in our outreach and that we specify that we provide materials unless they choose to use something different.
 - b. Sharing of any input from Tom Mattson of Public Works on their schedule for the installation of the Quick Build infrastructure:

Bonnie reported that Tom Mattson said the materials are ordered but not yet delivered so there is no firm update on the schedule. He did say the Art Location Maps with Dimensions "looked good to him". We will need Public Works to be involved for safety cones, etc. Megan will reach out to Tom and cc Bonnie to ID dates for painting as they will need to be there or supply safety materials.
