Eligibility Criteria: (Only applications with “Yes” answers to all the following questions are eligible to apply for funding)

1. Is the irrigation water for the applicant’s commercial cannabis cultivation sourced from a well or surface diversion during the dry season (May through October)? (Y/N)
2. Can the project be developed without removing any trees? (Y/N)
3. Does the applicant have a California state license for commercial cannabis cultivation? (Y/N)
4. Does the applicant have either a Humboldt County permit or interim permit for commercial cannabis cultivation? (Y/N)
5. Does the applicant have a Humboldt County Business License for commercial cannabis cultivation? (Y/N)
6. Are all of the applicant’s Humboldt County cannabis cultivation taxes current? (Y/N)
7. Are all of the applicant’s County cannabis cultivation permit fees paid? (Y/N)

Note: While any of the above answers are marked “N”, make the following text appear in red: **“Since one or more responses to the above questions is “No”, the application is not eligible for this funding program and will not be considered for funding.”**
