If you have medical needs, you may be referred to a primary care provider to assist with managing your health.



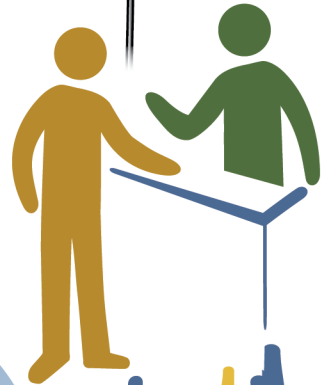
If at any time after receiving BH services you need additional support, you are welcome to contact us again.

We will assist you in connecting with a provider for services and with locating other supportive services including medical care, housing, social services, and insurance benefits if necessary.
