The Humboldt County LEA received an application on June 7, 2022 for a permit authorizing the continued operation of this Medium Volume Processing Facility as the result of a recent change in operator. ERT&S CDI is now operated by Dominick Hardin and two other individuals. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to enforce state laws and regulations regarding solid waste handling within the unincorporated areas of Humboldt County as well as within Humboldt County cities, including Fortuna. LEA staff accepted the application for the facility on September 23, 2022 as complete and correct per California Code of Regulations Title 14 §18104.1 & §18104.2.

Facility Operation: This permit allows the facility to receive up to 175 tons per day of CDI debris. The facility may receive CDI debris from contractors, self-haul, and the facility's transportation vehicles. Debris will be load checked and sorted; salvageable material is separated for reuse. Residuals are stored in the southeast corner of the tip building; residual waste (i.e., solid waste) is brought to Anderson Landfill. Residual waste is to be at or below 40% of the total CDI debris received at the site each month. Facility operations are limited to the receipt, handling, storage, and subsequent transport of CDI debris only. Registration permits are valid for five years.

To Review the Permit Application: A copy of the permit application is available for review by appointment at the LEA office at 100 H Street, Suite 100, Eureka, CA 95501 from 8:30am–12:00pm and 1:00pm–5:00pm. Contact Sarah Sanders at (707) 268-2224 to schedule an appointment. Pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC) §44307, if any person files a petition or appeal and alleges that this agency has failed to act as required by law or regulation during the approval process, the agency shall hold a hearing in accordance with PRC §44310.
