

Humboldt County food-related resources

As the federal government shutdown continues, November CalFresh benefits are not currently being issued. Any benefits currently on your card are available to use. There are community resources you can access and keep your CalFresh eligibility. Below are some services available in the community.

- **Food for People:** Main location located at 307 W 14th St., Eureka, with multiple distribution days throughout the county. Income-eligible community members can “shop” through their food selection once per month.
- **Arcata House Food Pantry:** 501 Ninth St., Arcata. Arcata House Partnership works with Food for People to serve Arcata and the surrounding areas.
- **Blue Lake Rancheria Nutrition Programs:** 1 Aiyekwee Loop, Blue Lake. Focusing on Tribal members, elders and children. Multiple meal programs offered.
- **Community Resource Centers:** Multiple locations throughout Humboldt County with an array of services. Please visit the Humboldt Network of Family Resource Centers (hnfrc.org) to find the location near you.
- **Humboldt Senior Resource Center’s Heritage Café:** Main location located at 1910 California St., Eureka, with other locations throughout the county. Offering hot lunches in the dining centers, \$3.50 suggested donation per meal.
- **Betty Kwan Chinn Day Center:** 133 Seventh St., Eureka. Day center open 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday. Offering case management, food, employment and housing resources.
- **St. Vincent de Paul:** 35 W Third St., Eureka. Free meal served 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
