RECOMMENDATION:

(1) Adopt the Resolution of Intention to Form the Humboldt County-Wide Permanent Road Division No. 1000, setting _____ at 1:30 PM. for the public hearing and direct the Clerk of the Board to notice the public hearing in accordance with Government Code 6061.

DISCUSSION:

On August 28, 2001 the Board directed staff to proceed with the creation of Permanent Road Divisions (PRDs) as a means for unincorporated area property owners to improve and maintain their roads. The use of PRDs was recommended because it offers greater funding flexibility and a lower cost to the public than the use of County Service Areas (CSAs).

The Department of Public Works conducted a state-wide survey of county jurisdictions. After assessing the results of the study, staff recommended and the Board of Supervisors directed staff to pursue a Permanent Road Division to allow for the formation of a County-wide district which would allow for individual areas of benefit (zones).
