To the attention of the Board of Supervisors:

Thank you for looking again at the Guiding Principles. My message to you today us that I strongly 'second' the request from Joyce King that you received yesterday, as copied below.

I would add that the reference she makes to the state's General Plan Guidelines and the goals and principles seems very important to me. In fact, these statements are so concise yet understandable/meaningful that they make a good model for guiding principles in general, it seems to me. Just some examples of phrases that I think could be on a list to use when one of 'our' principles are being looked at are these specific ones:

. Promote transit-oriented development.

Protect open space and working landscapes.

Conserve prime agricultural lands.

Conserve lands of scenic and recreational value.

Use open space to define urban communities

(Fyi, I am a neighbor of Joyce King in McKinleyville, and I had asked her to let me know if she communicated with you again, and she kindly sent me a copy of her message to you.)

A final thought: national and regional commentary regarding the new Climate Report from the UN emphasizes that addressing climate change is a matter of urgency, and whenever the Board can work this concern into your deliberations that is appreciated. The county, as we know, will be affected.
