## General Plan Update Workshop McKinleyville Draft Land Use Map

**Where: McKinleyville – Azalea Hall (1620 Picket Road)**

**When: Wednesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm**

### Purpose of the Workshop

A public workshop jointly sponsored by Humboldt County Community Development Services and the McKinleyville Community Services District will be held to discuss what the General Plan Update means for McKinleyville.

The workshop will provide the public with an opportunity to review the draft General Plan Land Use Maps and allow county staff and local service providers to share information concerning infrastructure and land use development issues.

The maps will show proposed land use designations under four plan alternatives. The alternatives will focus on housing, infrastructure, and public services within the watersheds. The workshop will feature PowerPoint presentations that review the General Plan Update Process to date, watershed conditions, current infrastructure capacity, planned improvements, and a comparison of alternatives. The final part of the workshop will involve a public discussion regarding the draft land use maps. Assistance from County staff will be available to those who want to discuss specific land use issues during the meeting.
