3. Please provide brief description of proposal for which you are seeking funding.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has awarded the County a 90.66% grant to Update Airport Layout Plan (ALP) at the Arcata-Eureka Airport (ACV). This funding request is only for match funding necessary to fulfill the FAA grant requirement.

4. *Measure Z* funding is scheduled to "sunset" in 2020. How are you developing a plan for sustainability, including diversification of funding sources, in order for your proposal to carry on without reliance on future *Measure Z* funds?

The Aviation Division uses the Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) program as match funding for Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grants offered through the FAA. A PFC is a \$4.50 fee added to airline tickets and collected by the origin airport. With the decline in passengers at ACV there is insufficient PFC funding to match the FAA grant which will cause the completion of the ARFF facility to be postponed indefinitely. Therefore this is a one-time contribution request due to a lack of available PFC funds and time constraints associated with the conditions of the FAA grant award.

5. If this request is for the continuation, or expansion, of an existing program/service, what is the current source of funding for that program/service?

As noted in items #3 and #4 above, this request will expand on an FAA grant award already in place and accepted by the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors.

6. If you are awarded *Measure Z* funds, how will you use them to leverage additional grants, contributions, or community support?

The Measure Z funds will be used as the County's required match for the committed FAA grant amount of \$75,550.

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## Update Airport Layout Plan for the Arcata-Eureka Airport

### Proposal Narrative

Arcata-Eureka Airport (ACV) is a commercial airport that operates in compliance with Title 14 Code of Federal Regulations Part 139 (Part 139). Part 139 requirements cover commercial airports with service scheduled and unscheduled air carrier aircraft, and

Airport improvements and maintenance of aviation data and clearances are crucial to a safe and viable airport. The Airport Layout Plan (ALP) is a high priority with Federal Aviation Administration and all airport improvements and/or maintenance of aviation data and clearances must comply with an FAA approved ALP. FAA has directed the County to update the ALP for ACV.

On August 12, 2014, the County executed a grant with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to Update Airport Layout Plan (ALP) for the Arcata-Eureka Airport (ACV). Update will include as-built information for any projects completed since the last ALP approval. Existing and proposed airfield facilities will be evaluated based upon the new FAA guidelines, *Airport Design*. Data tables will be updated and expanded to reflect current FAA standards. ALP will be consistent with the *ALP National Checklist*.

Airport by nature are high risk, therefore an appropriate plan for improvements, maintenance and data information is key to their safety. One of the basic functions of FAA is aviation safety and Airport Layout Plans are necessary to operate an airport in accordance with FAA standards.

### Program Budget

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant will provide the majority of funding for the Airport Layout Plan Update for the Arcata-Eureka Airport and the County will provide a balancing percentage of matching funds. The anticipated total project cost for the project and the associated cost sharing distributions are as follows:
