NOTICE REGARDING THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

The County of Humboldt has entered into a Consent Decree with the Department of Justice (DOJ) regarding offices and facilities that do not currently meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. Under the terms of the agreement, the DOJ has given us timelines for compliance. While needed repairs are made, temporary accommodations will be available at any and all locations not currently in compliance, to make sure all citizens and clients are able to access our facilities. Home services can be provided in certain situations.
