### **Re: City of Arcata Measure Z Quarterly Report**

#### **Measure Z 3rd Quarterly Narrative Fiscal Year 2017-18**

- 1. Please describe the Measure Z activities completed and/or total numbers served or reached.*

During the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, the School Resource Officer responded to 57 incidents on school campuses (see attached spreadsheet).

As of April 16, 2018, the Juvenile Diversion Counselors (JDC's) have provided services to 186 K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students and families in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Supervisorial District and the western portion of the 5<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District (west of Berry Summit). The program has been referred 48 cases via law enforcement (e.g., APD, HCSO, EPD, Juvenile Probation), 77 school referred cases, and 13 School Attendance Review Board (SARB) referred cases. Diversion has actively provided Brief Intervention Drug and Alcohol Counseling (an evidence-based alcohol and other drug program for adolescents) to 93 youth currently with drug related citations or school infractions that have them placed on a suspended/expulsion contract.

As of April 16, 2018, the Arcata Police Department (APD) Diversion program has a 96% successful completion rate! Successes from the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter include 25 cases that were closed due to successfully completing the APD Diversion program.

Crystal Perez, APD JDC, and Danielle Carmesin, Assistant Principal of McKinleyville High School, facilitated the 2<sup>nd</sup> APD Diversion hosted Parent Project class which concluded January 17, 2018. Cedric Aaron, APD JDC, and Victoria Marr, APD School Resource Officer (SRO), are currently facilitating the 3<sup>rd</sup> APD Diversion hosted Parent Project class which began on March 8, 2018 for 11 weeks at Arcata High School.

During this last quarter, the JDCs participated in the following trainings: HSU School of Social Work Field Instructor Training (through Humboldt State University) and Dimensions of Racism Training (through City of Arcata). During this last quarter, Victoria Marr, APD SRO, participated in the following trainings: Dimensions of Racism Training (through City of Arcata), Fair and Impartial Treatment Training (through City of Arcata), and 40-hour School Resource Officer training (through California's Peace Officer Standards and Training in the Sacramento, CA region). Victoria Marr has also collaborated with the Northern Humboldt Union High School

District in developing a Threat Assessment Guidance Document to address potential incidents of dangerous threats (e.g., gun violence, bomb threat) on school campuses.

APD Diversion Team had accompanied a group of Pacific Coast and Arcata High School students on Job Shadow field trip. During the last quarter, APD Diversion Team had collaborated with community allies (e.g., CHP, Arcata High School, HCSO, Arcata Sunrise Rotary) to host the Every 15 Minutes program scheduled for April 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> at Arcata High School. Crystal Perez, APD JDC, is one of the co-chair coordinators for the Every 15 Minutes (E15M) for both Arcata High School's Interagency Team meetings and Rotary Sunrise's E15M Committee. APD Diversion Team also participated in the Child Abuse Services Team (SART)'s Council Roundtable to address child neglect prevention in problematic substance use. The JDCs had assisted McKinleyville Middle School in receiving specialized weekly mentoring services from Humboldt State University's Y.E.S. program. APD Diversion Team and Anne Salhberg, McKinleyville High School Academic Counselor, will be co-facilitating a weekly high school transition, from April 27, 2018 to June 8, 2018, for 8<sup>th</sup> graders at McKinleyville Middle School.

The JDCs are active community partners with the following multi-agency teams and participate in monthly-quarterly meetings to better serve our community: Multi-Agency Crisis Intervention Team (collaboration with local law enforcement departments, DHHS, and other community partners to serve local homeless/houseless and mentally ill populations), Child Abuse Services Team, SARB, Arcata and McKinleyville High Schools' Sources of Strength, Black Student Union at McKinleyville and (in the near future) Arcata High Schools, Humboldt Allies for Substance Abuse Prevention, Humboldt State University's Y.E.S. & School of Social Work, Juvenile Justice Delinquency & Prevention Commission, Meth/Opiate Task Force and Suicide Prevention Network. The APD Diversion team are also collaborating with Humboldt County Sheriff's Office Gang Resource Intelligence Team.

- 2. What difference did Measure Z funding make in our community and for the population you are serving? Please discuss evidence of effect (e.g., community indicators, outcomes, etc.).*

The program's long term goals are to reduce by 50% the amount of Juvenile Crime in the service area and reduce by 50% the number of high school students who dropout and/or go to continuation high schools for incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders. The program is too new to quantify effect at this time.

- 3. Describe any unanticipated impacts of receiving Measure Z funding, positive or negative, not already described above.*

At this time, we have not experienced any unanticipated impacts of receiving Measure Z funding.
