

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-28

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL
MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018, FOR THE
SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS A QUESTION RELATING TO A SUPPLEMENTAL
TRANSACTION AND USE TAX SPECIFIC TO ROAD IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Charter a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 6, 2018, for the election Municipal Officers; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the Charter, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Eureka, California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2018.

SECTION 2. That THE City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, does order submitted to the voters at the General Municipal Election the following question:

Shall the Eureka Municipal Code be amended to add a one-quarter of one percent supplemental transaction and use tax to fund street, road, and alleyway maintenance and pothole repair, raising approximately 2.2 million dollars annually, with the following restrictions? <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The tax will expire after twenty years, unless reauthorized by voters.• A citizen's oversight committee shall be established to conduct annual audits of all expenditures generated by the tax to ensure fiscal accountability and public participation. SECTION 3. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to coordinate with the County of Humboldt County Clerk to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 5. That the polls for the election shall be open at seven o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8 o'clock p.m. of the day of the election and shall pursuant to Election Code § 10242, except as provided in § 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

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
SECTION 6. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 7. That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.


SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.


