Dear Board and Staff -

I want to register my desire for the public to have more time to review zoning decisions being proposed on County properties, particularly on properties currently zoned 'unclassified'.

These zoning decisions will have a big influence on the lived experience of residents for many years in the future. I request (dare I say demand?) that the supervisors give residents an opportunity to review these decisions, with maps, and to have an opportunity to comment, and to be thoughtful about their region, about the place they call home.

I attended a citizen meeting about the Glendale/Fieldbrook region just the other night, with over 100 people in attendance - very concerned about the proposed changes, and the lack of community input.

The citizens of Bayside have more recently become aware of the proposed changes and have not had time to meet and discuss over maps.

Please take your job as a representative of the people seriously and allow people more time to review these proposed changes, and to respond with thoughtful ideas. This beautiful county of Humboldt depends on your respect for its citizens. Please vote to allow citizens time to review the changes to zoning.
