I am told I have until June 14,2019 to ask my questions: To do that I would like to known very specifically what changes to our existing environment will be necessary to make this happen. What changes to the Bay itself? To the boat ramp? The parking lot? The Jimmy Smith historical designation that this is a use area for the local residents with the future plans of a playground having been promised?

I request a meeting for the Fields Landing people to have an input,. And please notify everyone involved. The Tourism Bureau, The Fisherman's Association. The Wiyot Tribe, HSU and College of the Redwoods who study the ecology of the area. The Coastal Commission comes to mind and FEMA which just declared this to be a flood zone.

Make your findings public now please and not in an online 800 page document as suggested.

Specifically I request all information regarding the impact to Fields Landing be sent to me on paper via the USPS to Carol Michael at P.O. Box 116, Fields Landing ,California .I ask that I be sent this information promptly so I can make copies and provide them to my neighbors and everyone else effected.

My request is reasonable. You in San Diego or even New York have no idea of the damage you are proposing to this very unique place: Redwood Country.
