Dear Project Planner,

Dear Planning Director John Ford,

I am opposed to the proposed Terra Gen wind project from Humboldt Wind, LLC. While I do recognize that climate change is a serious threat to Humboldt County, this project is poorly sited will cause severe environmental and cultural impacts. As Terra-Gen makes clear in their DEIR, the project is likely to result in death of numerous special-status species, such as the marbled murrelet, and may cause population-level impacts to once-numerous species, such as the hoary bat.

The project also has significant impacts on tribal resources of the Wiyot Tribe. As the DEIR states very clearly, "Project operation would permanently alter the character of this tribal cultural resource, which is a cumulatively considerable contribution to the cumulative loss of cultural resources in the county." That said, the DEIR fails to detail adequate mitigation measures to avoid, minimize, and compensate for these significant environmental and cultural impact. I believe the impacts of this project are not mitigatable, and the project should be denied.
