I would like to register my opposition to the wind energy project proposal for the Monument and Bear River Ridges, not only because of the impacts to listed and threatened wildlife and unique ridge top of significance to local Native Americans and California Land Surveyors Association, but also because of misinformation and deceptions from the project proponents.

These impact assessments are based on faulty research, models, and calculations. Mitigations in general have poor track records, with low success rates and poor follow-up and enforcement. Cumulative impacts, which take into account historic trends and foreseeable future changes are also not well analyzed, and become more difficult as climate change effects ramp up.

The atmospheric carbon savings of this projects when calculated from cradle to grave look minimal at best. There are much more deserving alternatives (roof top solar?) which this project would most likely eclipse.

In the long term, the probable impacts seem to far outweigh any benefits to the community and to the environment.

Please do not be swept into this rushed process which seems to be heavily motivated by this company's desire to cash in on tax benefits which end this year.
