There is no urgency to the installation of these wind turbines but there is a pressing need to improve the image of Eureka and the access to us.
That we have deep harbors that aren't being used because 101 can't service the activity this would bring is unacceptable and foolish.
I suggest all of his interest and attention be refocused to an issue all of Humboldt could agree upon. Upgrade our highway, re-route it, whatever plan best suits the purpose of using the resources we already have.
