As one of the 100+ parcel owners receiving notification of a draft EOR, I responded to the Planning Department focusing on the noise impact of this project.

I firmly believe the identified parcels is based on lines on a map and hundreds of other parcels will be subjected to the 24/7 noise issues once the 60 turbines are operating at full capacity.

With the proposed clear cutting, the forest habitat will be permanently altered forcing wild life into neighboring camp grounds and residential areas, as they seek a safe space.

As a homeowner in Sonoma County, I am on high alert to fires caused by a single spark and Bear River Ridge is just dry grass! Trucks and turbines provide a potential major fire risk.
