 As a fifth generation landowner in the Bear River Watershed I oppose the Terra Gen project. There are numerous areas of grave concern about the process so far, the DEIR, construction methods and materials, and ongoing environmental and economic damage throughout and following the existence of the project.

Foremost in my mind is the tremendous pollution and damage that will result from making, transporting, and placing in the ground the millions of tons of concrete that the project would require. Putting the massive concrete pads in the ground threatens the existence of the natural, underground water supply, drainage, soil, and some of the healthiest, most productive forests and land in the country.
