Re: Terra-Gen Wind Project/Humboldt County

The On-Line Report concerning this project indicates that the materials needed to build these wind turbines will be shipped across Humboldt Bay and unloaded on the Fields Landing Boat Ramp.

No where in this 800 page report can I discern any concrete answer to the question of what damage will be caused to the environment , to the Bay itself and to the nature of our town by the use of our small harbor in this uncommon commercial endeavor

No mention is made of the fact that one Jimmy Smith (departed) when he was Supervisor indicated that this area would be for recreational use of the inhabitants of Fields Landing and others and that a plan was implemented to make this happen and it was. A memorial plaque to Smith is at the head of the ramp.


No where is there any mention of the **Aleutian Geese** who migrate here each year ,making their home on Table Bluff which is in The National Wildlife Reserve just south of Fields Landing .I would think these geese are a protected species. They are the ones that travel in v shaped patterns making the exact same trip each year. What will be the impact to these birds which go unmentioned in this report?

FEMA recently declared Fields Landing to be in a flood zone and all homeowners have been required to purchase homeowner's insurance. What effect will the conversion of our quiet bay into a commercial endeavor have on our vulnerability to flooding or, isn't there a conflict in standards being applied?

Also, we are known here as Triple Junction, the meeting of three plates rendering us earthquake prone. Many of the earthquakes originate in the bay or the waters off of Ferndale. Has this been addressed? Will our risk increase? Again I don't see this in the report. It is 800 pages and I may have missed some of these things but I am waiting a hard copy which I have requested and which should be easier to read.

My main question to you is has there been a study by EPA on this project.?My second question is does this project fall under the jurisdiction of the Coastal Commission.?

If there is a report may I have a copy please .If there isn't one, may I have the reasoning for that decision?.
