As a landowner in the Bear River Watershed I oppose the Terra Gen project. If approved this project will do irreversible damage to our native grasslands, wildlife and watershed and will forever change the way of life we hold dear. Terra-Gen's huge corporate wind project is being rushed through all the "red tape." To whose benefit we wonder? Definitely not ours, not our land, and not our wildlife. There has been little time to study the enormous environmental impacts. The DEIR is incomplete and there are many very important issues that have not been resolved, such as water acquisition for the concrete, the possible effects of the enormous weight on aquifers in a highly seismic area, and the turbines effect on deciduous species. Until these issues and many others, that have been overlooked and glossed over, or just ignored in the DEIR can be answered for, the project should not be given the green light. Is the County of Humboldt going to collect revenue off of the backs of the people of the Bear River Watershed by crushing them with *30 thousand ton cement turbine bases* for subsidy money? You will crush our ground water resevoirs, smash the life out of our springs and forever blight the wide open grasslands of our beautiful Bear River Ridge. I strongly oppose the Terra-Gen project.
