



## **Humboldt County Cannabis Business Micro-Grant Frequently Asked Questions Addendum/Update November 21, 2019**

**The application says that the applicant must be Humboldt County based, having 75% or more of its operations based in Humboldt County and must be licensed and registered to operate in Humboldt County. What do you mean by Humboldt County? Does that mean I can't operate or be located within any city limits?**

- For the purposes of this application, being in "Humboldt County" means that you operate within the geographic limits of the county. You can be located within any town or jurisdiction within the county limits.

**Please explain the difference between individuals and co-operatives (co-ops) or associations.**

- An individual is defined as a single person or business enterprise. An individual would apply for a grant to benefit just one individual or business. A co-op or association is made up of more than one person or business. A grant award to a co-op or association would benefit more than one individual or business. Road Associations made up of multiple parties are an example of an association.
