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Narrative: On 12/8/06 at about 2345 hours, I was telephoned by Tactical Dispatcher [REDACTED]. She advised me that the Eureka Police Department SWAT team had been involved in a shooting and Lt. George Cavinta was requesting I respond to assist in the investigation along with other (Critical Incident Response Team) CIRT members that were also being notified. The CIRT members were to meet at the Super 8 Motel in Eureka, Ca.

I was aware that Police and Humboldt County Sheriff's Office SWAT members were at the Super 8 Motel with a barricaded male subject who was possibly armed with a gun. The standoff began sometime on 12/7/06, with Police Swat members securing the area and Sheriff's SWAT members later assisting the Police Department.

On 12/9/06 at about 0006 hours, I left my residence en route for the Super 8 Motel. At about 0026 hours, I arrived at the Super 8 Motel and met with Lt. Cavinta. Lt. Cavinta advised me that the [REDACTED] was deceased and his name was [REDACTED]. Lt. Cavinta advised me that Detectives Ben Nord, Marvin Kirkpatrick and Steve Quenell were also en route to the scene to assist with the investigation.

At about 0040 hours, I met with District Attorney Investigator Mike Losey who had arrived at the Motel. Investigator Losey advised me that the CIRT team was going to meet at the Eureka Police Department. I left the scene and arrived at the Police Department at about 0051 hours. At the Police Department I met with CIRT members. At about 0145 hours, we began briefing and split into teams with certain assignments. I telephoned Lt. Cavinta via cell phone and he advised me that he was going to bring the Sheriff's Office SWAT members to the Sheriff's Office to standby. I advised Lt. Cavinta to prepare a list of Sheriff's Office personnel that was at the Super 8 Motel during the incident.

Det. Quenell and I were then assigned by Investigator Losey to count the rounds in the weapons of the Police Department's SWAT members who did not discharge their weapons.

At about 0219 hours, Det. Quenell and I met with these SWAT members in the Police Department's armory and began the round counts. I counted the rounds and Det. Quenell logged the results. Refer to his report for details. It should be noted that Det. Ron Harpham, who was a SWAT member turned his tazer over to me, which he stated he had discharged at [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. At about 0341 hours, I turned this tazer over to Eureka Police Department Evidence Technician [REDACTED].

At about 0453 hours, Investigator Losey asked me to interview [REDACTED] [REDACTED] brother. According to Investigator Losey, [REDACTED] had spoken to [REDACTED] while he was barricaded in the Motel. This information was passed onto Investigator Losey from Eureka Police Department Det. Neil Hubbard.

At about 0505 hours, Det. Quenell and I left the Police Department and arrived at the Super 8 Motel at about 0514 hours. At about 0600 hours, I met with Investigator Losey and Eureka Police Department Det. Kurt Honeycutt. They showed me a hallway that was located in the middle area of the Motel. They advised me that [REDACTED] was barricaded in room [REDACTED]. I then advised Investigator Losey that Det. Quenell and I were going to go to the Sheriff's Office and I was going to telephone [REDACTED]. Det. Quenell and I left the Motel at about 0612 hours.

On 12/9/06 at about 0615 hours, I telephoned [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]. The interview was digitally recorded and later placed onto CD. The following is a summary of that interview.

I explained to [REDACTED] that I was a member of the CIRT team and I had spoken to Eureka Police Department Det. Neil Hubbard and Det. Hubbard advised me that [REDACTED] had spoken to [REDACTED] at one point. [REDACTED] said the last time he had spoken to [REDACTED] was on 12/7/06.

[REDACTED] told me that he was at his place of employment and [REDACTED] telephoned [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] cell phone at about 1630 hours. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was speaking quietly and [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to speak up and [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he couldn't because "they'll hear me". [REDACTED] went on to tell [REDACTED] that he wanted [REDACTED] to know that he loved him and that "they" got me. [REDACTED] said when [REDACTED] said "they"; [REDACTED] knew [REDACTED] was referring to law enforcement. [REDACTED] said that he had not spoken to [REDACTED] since, because the Police Department had [REDACTED]'s cell phone turned off and [REDACTED] did not try to call the Motel.

I asked [REDACTED] what his response was when [REDACTED] told him that he loved him. [REDACTED] said that he knew that [REDACTED] was going to die. [REDACTED] said that he felt [REDACTED] also knew that he was going to die.

I asked [REDACTED] if he knew of anything else going on in [REDACTED] life and [REDACTED] asked me if it was in regards to the [REDACTED] charges. I told [REDACTED] that was correct.

█████ said from what he knew another female had come forward and said that █████ had █████ her.

I asked █████ if he knew █████ was wanted by police. █████ said he did know and had received a telephone call from █████ told █████ that he had been out fishing and fled from Sheriff's Office Deputies when █████ had returned home. █████ said from what he knew, █████ telephoned the Trinity County Sheriff's Office and asked what was going on but they would not tell him. █████ telephoned his attorney and this was when █████ found out there was another █████ charge against him.

█████ told █████ that he was not going to go back to jail and █████ knew from this point that █████ would end up dead. I asked █████ if █████ told him that he was going to have a standoff with police and █████ said he didn't think that █████ meant that but he knew that █████ would not go back to jail.

I asked █████ if he knew of █████ having any guns. █████ said that █████ had all sorts of guns and █████ described █████ as a "mountain man". █████ said that █████ did not carry the guns on his person but he did carry the guns in his vehicles.

I asked █████ how he heard that █████ had been shot. █████ said that he received a telephone call from █████ daughter who had heard the news from █████ █████ █████ son. █████ said that █████ had telephoned the Motel and actually heard gunshots over the telephone.

█████ added that his own personal feelings were that law enforcement did all they could do for the situation they were put in. █████ felt █████ got to this point because of the █████ charges that were against him, which involved █████ and █████ niece and █████'s wife's half-sister and now there was a third female that came forward.


█████ said these █████ allegations had been going on for about 2 years and █████ actually spent 3 months in Trinity County Jail. █████ believed that spending time in jail for █████ was just too much. This concluded my interview with █████

After speaking with █████ Det. Quenell and I returned to the Super 8 Motel at about 0738 hours. It was later determined that DOJ (Department of Justice) Agents would be taking the primary role in this investigation and the Humboldt County District Attorney's Office would take the secondary. At about 1030 hours, Lt. Steve Knight advised me that I could clear from the scene.

The CD interview of █████ was placed into evidence at the Sheriff's Office. A copy of this case and the CD was turned over to Det. Honeycutt.

The communications center asked me if I would be able to respond to Eureka Police Department regarding an officer involved shooting. I was asked to respond for the Critical Incident Response Team.

Around 0115 Hours, I arrived at Eureka Police Department and met with other members with the Critical Incident Response Team (Humboldt County District Attorney Investigators M. Losey and C. Andrews, Eureka Police Department Detectives C. Honeycutt and K. Lawson, Arcata Police Department Detective G. Bates, Humboldt County Sheriff's Office Detectives R. Schlesiger, S. Quenell, and B. Nord, and Fortuna Police Department Sergeant J. Bernstein).

They advised me that Eureka Police Department (EPD) was in an officer involved shooting and that I am requested to respond to EPD for the Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT).

At about 0100 hours, I arrived at EPD and went to the investigation division where I met with other members of the CIRT team. (Refer to Det. Kirkpatrick's report for CIRT members)

DA Investigator Losey requested Det. Kirkpatrick and I respond to the Super 8 Motel to replace EPD Lt. Zanotti and EPD volunteers. He further requested that I take photographs of some EPD equipment so that it could be removed and placed back at the Eureka Police Department.



We arrived at about 0400 hours. I took digital photographs of the equipment in rooms [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Lt. Zanoliti then removed two large banks of radio chargers. At about 0445 hours all the volunteer patrol personnel left the scene. I secured the West side of Super 8 while Det. Kirkpatrick secured the East side. [REDACTED] was escorted to my car where we spoke inside of it. The conversation was digitally recorded and later transferred to CD-R, which was booked into evidence. This is a summary of our conversation:

[REDACTED] said that he was guest at the motel on Thursday, December 7, 2006 when he was asked to leave his room by the EPD. He left most of his personal belongings inside the motel. He went to another motel in the Eureka area. [REDACTED] said that he did not hear or see anything that could assist CIRT in the investigation because he left his room early in the morning and would arrive back at it late in the evening. This was due to his job as a traveling salesman. Our conversation ended shortly after this.

I escorted [REDACTED] to his room and took digital photographs of it prior to him removing any items. [REDACTED] then removed his personal belongings and left the scene.

At about 0755 hours, the manager of the Super 8, [REDACTED], requested to go into several rooms and remove items that belonged to guests. I took digital photographs of rooms # [REDACTED] and # [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] removed all personal effects from the room so that they could be returned to motel guests.

NOTE: All photographs were transferred to a CD-R and booked into evidence.

At about 1030 hours, HCSO Lt. Knight told me that the Department of Justice along with the District Attorney's Office was conducting the investigation and that all HCSO personnel are relieved. I cleared the scene and went off duty.

█████ added that his own personal feelings were that law enforcement did all they could do for the situation they were put in. █████ felt █████ got to this point because of the █████ charges that were against him, which involved █████ and █████ niece and █████'s wife's half-sister and now there was a third female that came forward.


█████ said these █████ allegations had been going on for about 2 years and █████ actually spent 3 months in Trinity County Jail. █████ believed that spending time in jail for █████ was just too much. This concluded my interview with █████

After speaking with █████ Det. Quenell and I returned to the Super 8 Motel at about 0738 hours. It was later determined that DOJ (Department of Justice) Agents would be taking the primary role in this investigation and the Humboldt County District Attorney's Office would take the secondary. At about 1030 hours, Lt. Steve Knight advised me that I could clear from the scene.

The CD interview of █████ was placed into evidence at the Sheriff's Office. A copy of this case and the CD was turned over to Det. Honeycutt.

Around 0115 Hours, I arrived at Eureka Police Department and met with other members with the Critical Incident Response Team (Humboldt County District Attorney Investigators M. Losey and C. Andrews, Eureka Police Department Detectives C. Honeycutt and K. Lawson, Arcata Police Department Detective G. Bates, Humboldt County Sheriff's Office Detectives R. Schlesiger, S. Quenell, and B. Nord, and Fortuna Police Department Sergeant J. Bernstein).

Investigator Losey asked Detective Nord and I to respond to Super 8 Motel and replace Eureka Police Department Lieutenant A. Zanotti and some of Eureka Police Department Volunteer Patrol members due to them being up so many hours. At the Motel, I met with Eureka Police Department Lieutenant A. Zanotti. Lieutenant Zanotti showed me the area and crime scene. Lieutenant Zanotti collected battery chargers and batteries from one of the rooms they were using after Detective took digital photographs of them. Lieutenant Zanotti then left the scene.

Around 0445 hours, the Eureka Police Department Volunteer Patrol members ([REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]) had to leave and Detective Nord and I took over security on the scene.

Detective Nord stood on the west side of the building while I had the east side. Detective Nord and I keep logs of subjects coming and going from the crime scene (motel).

On Saturday, December 8, 2006 at about 0030, I received a telephone call at my residence from the HCSO communication center. They advised me that Eureka Police Department (EPD) was in an officer involved shooting and that I am requested to respond to EPD for the Critical Incident Response Team (CIRT).

At about 0100 hours, I arrived at EPD and went to the investigation division where I met with other members of the CIRT team. (Refer to Det. Kirkpatrick's report for CIRT members)

DA Investigator Losey requested Det. Kirkpatrick and I respond to the Super 8 Motel to replace EPD Lt. Zanotti and EPD volunteers. He further requested that I take photographs of some EPD equipment so that it could be removed and placed back at the Eureka Police Department.

We arrived at about 0400 hours. I took digital photographs of the equipment in rooms [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Lt. Zanoliti then removed two large banks of radio chargers. At about 0445 hours all the volunteer patrol personnel left the scene. I secured the West side of Super 8 while Det. Kirkpatrick secured the East side. I kept a log of all personnel entering from the West side. Refer to Det. Kirkpatrick's log for the East side.

At about 0625 hours, DA Investigator Losey requested that I speak and obtain a statement from a motel guest. His name was [REDACTED] and he was staying in room number [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was escorted to my car where we spoke inside of it. The conversation was digitally recorded and later transferred to CD-R, which was booked into evidence. This is a summary of our conversation:

[REDACTED] said that he was guest at the motel on Thursday, December 7, 2006 when he was asked to leave his room by the EPD. He left most of his personal belongings inside the motel. He went to another motel in the Eureka area. [REDACTED] said that he did not hear or see anything that could assist CIRT in the investigation because he left his room early in the morning and would arrive back at it late in the evening. This was due to his job as a traveling salesman. Our conversation ended shortly after this.

I escorted [REDACTED] to his room and took digital photographs of it prior to him removing any items. [REDACTED] then removed his personal belongings and left the scene.

At about 0755 hours, the manager of the Super 8, [REDACTED], requested to go into several rooms and remove items that belonged to guests. I took digital photographs of rooms # [REDACTED] and # [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] removed all personal effects from the room so that they could be returned to motel guests.

NOTE: All photographs were transferred to a CD-R and booked into evidence.

At about 1030 hours, HCSO Lt. Knight told me that the Department of Justice along with the District Attorney's Office was conducting the investigation and that all HCSO personnel are relieved. I cleared the scene and went off duty.
