



Emergency Medical Services

You will not be denied emergency medical services based on your ability to pay.

You will not be denied services based on your race, color, sex, national origin, disability, or religion.

You have the right to receive, within the capabilities of this hospital staff and these facilities:

- An appropriate medical screening examination
- Necessary stabilizing treatment (including treatment for an unborn child)
- An appropriate transfer to another facility (if needed)

This includes whether:

You cannot pay, you do not have medical insurance, or you are not entitled to Medi-Care and Medi-Cal.

There is a sliding scale fee, based on the Uniform Method to Determine Ability to Pay (UMDAP).
