

Humboldt County COVID-19 Weekly Update: June 19, 2020

- As of June 19, 2020, Humboldt County has counted:
 - 110 total confirmed COVID-19 cases,
 - 13 hospitalizations due to COVID-19,
 - 101 recovered from COVID-19 and
 - 4 deaths due to COVID-19.
- **Case Growth:** The Humboldt County COVID-19 cases have grown from one case on February 20, 2020 to 110 cases on June 19, 2020.
- **Confirmed test rates:** The Humboldt County positive test rate is 81 confirmed tests per 100,000 people. The California confirmed positive test rate is 419 confirmed tests per 100,000 people. The United States confirmed positive test rate is 667 confirmed test per 100,000 people.
- **Demographics of Positive Cases:**
 - **Confirmed cases by region:**
 - Northern Humboldt: 21 cases
 - Greater Humboldt Bay Area: 85 cases
 - Southern Humboldt: 4 cases
 - **Gender:** The gender breakdown of COVID-19 cases is 42% male and 58% female.
 - **Age:** The average (mean) age of COVID-19 cases is 45 years old.
 - **Transmission data:**
 - Traveler-acquired: 24
 - Contact to known case: 61
 - Community transmission: 23
 - Under investigation: 2
- **Test rates:** Test rates have increased at the county, state and national level since the COVID-19 pandemic began. As of June 19, 2020, Humboldt County's test rate is 6,385 tests performed per 100,000 people. California's test rate is 7,698 tests performed per 100,000 people. The United States test rate is 7,711 tests performed per 100,000 people. Test rates have increased at the county, state and national level since the COVID-19 pandemic began.
 - Humboldt County's test rate has increased from 405 tests performed per 100,000 people on March 30, 2020 to 6,385 tests performed per 100,000 people on June 19, 2020.
 - California's test rate has increased from 127 tests performed per 100,000 people on March 30, 2020 to 7,698 tests performed per 100,000 people on June 19, 2020.

- The United States' test rate has increased from 287 tests performed per 100,000 people on March 30, 2020 to 7,711 tests performed per 100,000 people on June 19, 2020.
- **Tests Performed:** Of the 7,891 total tests performed for Humboldt County residents, 3,953 were performed by the Humboldt County Public Health Laboratory, 3,896 were performed by the OptumServe public testing site and 42 were performed by the Willow Creek public testing site.

As of June 2, 2020, due to issues with reporting accuracy and consistency, the number of tests reported by other commercial labs is now reported on a weekly basis only, on Mondays.
