**Please read this Order carefully. Violation of or failure to comply with this Order is a misdemeanor punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both. (California Health and Safety Code 120295, *et seq.*)**

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 101085, 120175, and Penal Code 409.5(a), THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT ("HEALTH OFFICER") ORDERS:

1. This Supplemental Order revises portions of the Health Officer's Order of November 3, 2020 ("November Order"). Any portion of the November Order not specifically modified by this Supplemental Order remains in effect. This Supplemental Order modifies prior requirements to submit a safety plan to the County and changes this process to approval through the County's Economic Development Department.
2. Section 16 of the November Order is modified to read as follows:

"A business approved by the County of Humboldt CAO's office of Economic Development for inclusion on the List or activity allowed under this Order shall comply with:

- a. The Sector-specific safety guidance's provided by the California Department of Public Health which may be found at: <https://humboldt.gov.org/2756/Business-Compliance> and through the County of Humboldt CAO's office of Economic Development's website at [www.gohumco.com](http://www.gohumco.com).
- b. The Health Officer's September 1, 2020 Facial Coverings Order which remains in full force and effect.
- c. Social distancing of 6 feet or more to the maximum extent possible.
- d. Any additional sector-specific provisions set forth in this Order.
- e. Approved businesses shall post their Humboldt County Certificate within public view on their website or make it available to the public upon request."

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3. Section 17 of the November Order is modified to read as follows:

“As activities are opened, sector-specific guidance will be posted on the County website and businesses may submit their request to the County of Humboldt CAO’s office of Economic Development for approval. Once a sector is approved by the State and a County certificate is issued, the business may begin providing that service upon compliance with the terms of this Order.”

4. This Order is effective upon signature until rescinded, and may be extended, rescinded, superseded, or amended in writing by the Health Officer.
5. Copies of this Order shall promptly be: (1) posted on the County website and (2) provided to any member of the public requesting a copy of this Order.
6. If any provision of this Order to the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, the remainder of the Order, including the application of such part or provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this Order are severable.
7. Except as modified herein, all provisions of the November 3, 2020 Order remain in full force and effect.
