## **35 New Cases Reported Today; Vaccination Appointments Available This Week**

Thirty-five new cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Humboldt County since the most recent report on Friday, bringing to 3,553 the total number of county residents who have tested positive for the virus.

Daily and weekly data on the Humboldt County Data Dashboard has been updated. Some highlights include:

- The confirmed case rate is 2,603 per 100,000 residents. The state and national rates are more than three times higher at 9,118 and 9,461 respectively.
- The 20-29 age group represents the highest number of local cases at 23.6%, followed by those in the 30-39 age group at 19.3%.

Vaccination is now open to all people age 16 and over, and appointments are available this week. Humboldt County received triple its previous weekly allocation of COVID-19 vaccine doses from the State of California. Local health officials warn that the state may adjust the county's allocations based on local uptake. The state can also redistribute already allocated doses to another county if they aren't used within seven days of delivery.

Community residents are urged to take the first appointment available for the first vaccine available. Many first-dose appointments are available at mass-vaccination clinics scheduled this week. Those who received an emailed invitation to register for their first dose through PrepMod should expect to receive a second dose invitation via email sometime over the next three weeks.
