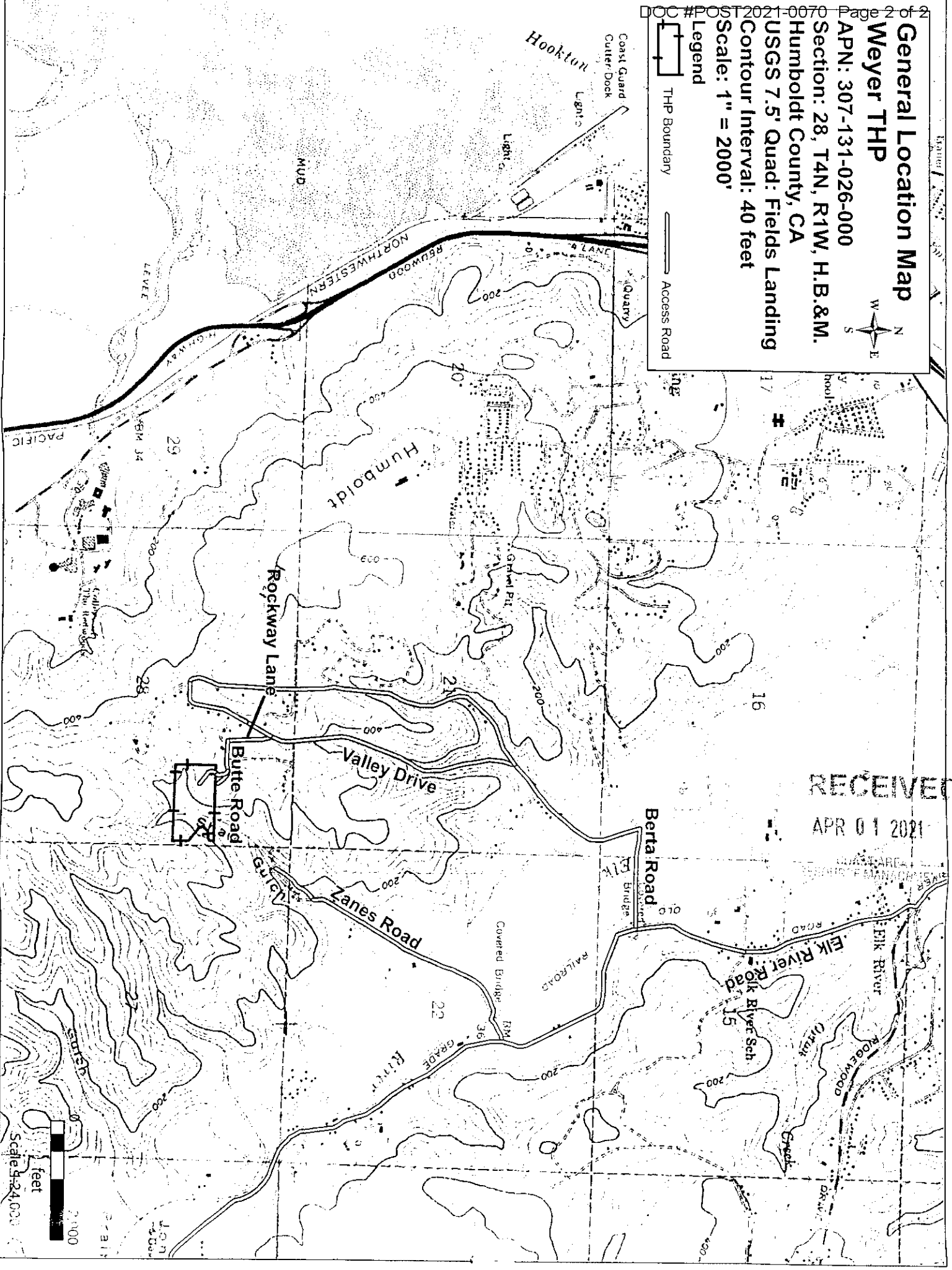

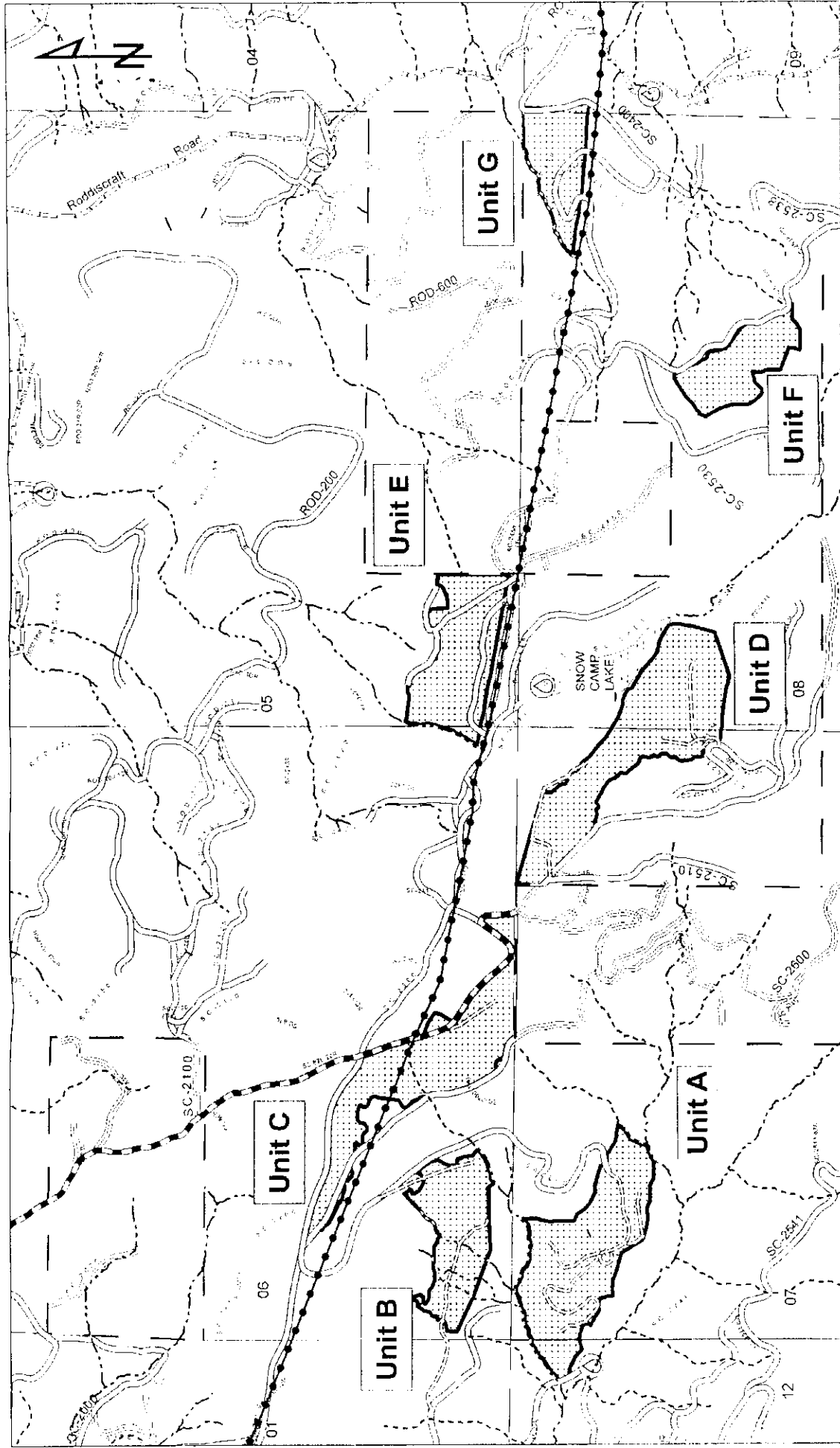

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Humboldt, as Lead Agency, in accordance with the State California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (finding of no significant adverse environmental effect) on the project described below. **This notification is to advise you that the Humboldt County Planning and Building Department will receive public comments on the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration from April 9, 2021 to May 10, 2021.**

PROJECT TITLE: Eel River Produce, LLC; APNs: 209-331-002; Record Number: PLN-2020-16417-SP.

APPLICANT: Eel River Produce, LLC

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Special Permit for 43,200 square feet of new commercial cannabis cultivation in eighteen (18) greenhouses, of which 10,000 square feet is mixed-light. The remaining fourteen greenhouses will have no supplemental lighting and use only light deprivation. The project also seeks one additional RRR cultivation entitlement of 20,000 square feet. Cultivation will occur from April 15th to October 15th and will achieve up to two harvest cycles. The site is permitted for 60,000 square feet of full-sun outdoor through three RRRs. The total cultivation at full build-out is 103,200 square feet (2.37 acres). A 10,000-square-foot commercial nursery in four (4) greenhouses will produce seeds and clones and was approved with a separate ZCC. No supplemental light is used in the light-deprivation or nursery greenhouses. The sole source of irrigation water is rainwater catchment captured directly in and stored in hard tanks. Estimated annual water use is 169,500 gallons, of which 19,000 gallons is used for the nursery. Water storage totals 120,000 gallons in twenty-four (24) hard tanks, with an additional 50,000 gallons proposed. At peak harvest, there will be up to fourteen (14) workers on-site. Harvested product will be dried in the greenhouses, or fresh frozen and taken off-site. No processing occurs on-site. P.G.&E. supplies renewable power to the site.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located in Humboldt County, in the Redcrest area, on the south side of Holmes Flat Road, approximately 1,700 feet west from the intersection of Holmes Flat road and Tierney Road, on the property known as 1048 Holmes Flat Road. PROJECT TITLE: Blocksburg Family Farms, LLC: APNs: 217-471-001; Record Number: PLN-12265-CUP.

APPLICANT: Blocksburg Family Farms, LLC

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Conditional Use Permit for six acres of new outdoor cultivation and 16,800 sf of existing outdoor cannabis on a parcel approximately 1,221 acres in size. Three acres of new would be grown using light deprivation techniques, with two harvests per year; three acres would be grown full sun with one harvest per year. The project has been broken into phases. In Phase I, the applicant would cultivate 60,360 sf full-term outdoor. In Phase II the applicant would cultivate the full amount of 278,160 sf outdoor cultivation. In Phase III the applicant would complete the solar installation and complete all operational improvements. All new cultivation would occur on approximately 16% of the prime agricultural soils on the parcel. The project includes a Special Permit for restoration activities within the Streamside Management Area (SMA). The project includes the relocation of 16,800 sf of cultivation out of an SMA. In Phase I, irrigation demand would be approximately 658,658 gallons per year. In Phase II & III, irrigation demand would be approximately 3,090,326 gallons per year. Water would be provided by an onsite well and one 1,000,000-gallon rainwater catchment tank. The project includes 6,000 sf of ancillary nursery space. 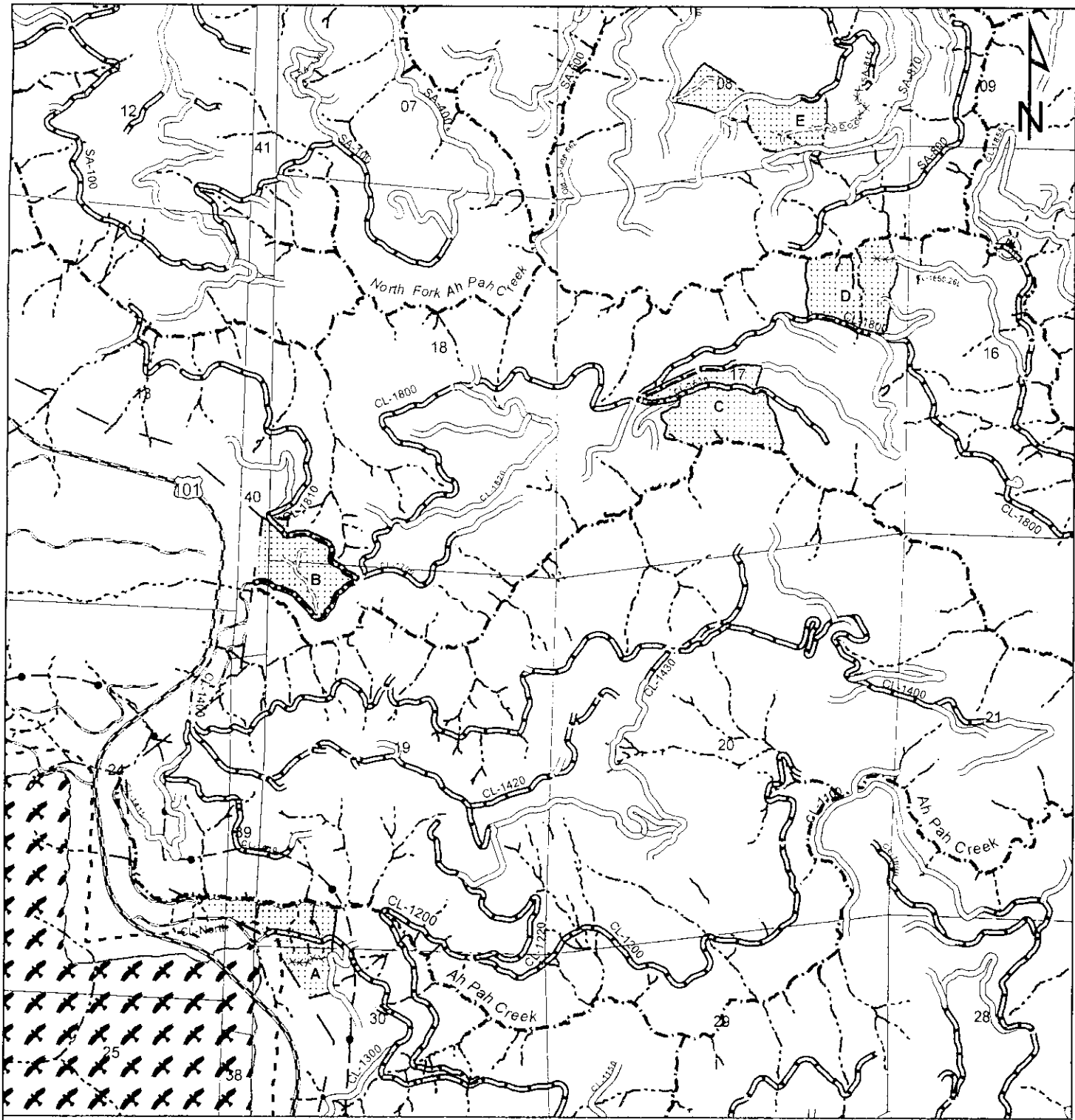
